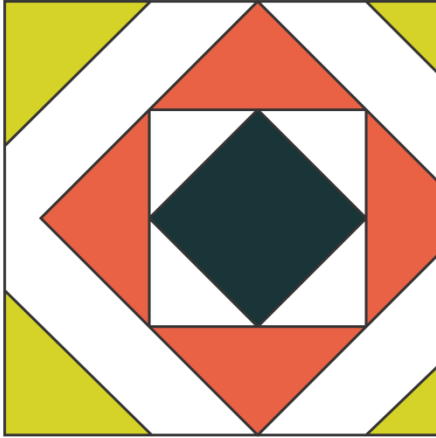




**Oakville Quilters' Guild**  
**Modern Block of the Month**  
**December - Diamonds**



Block size: 12.5" unfinished

You will need:

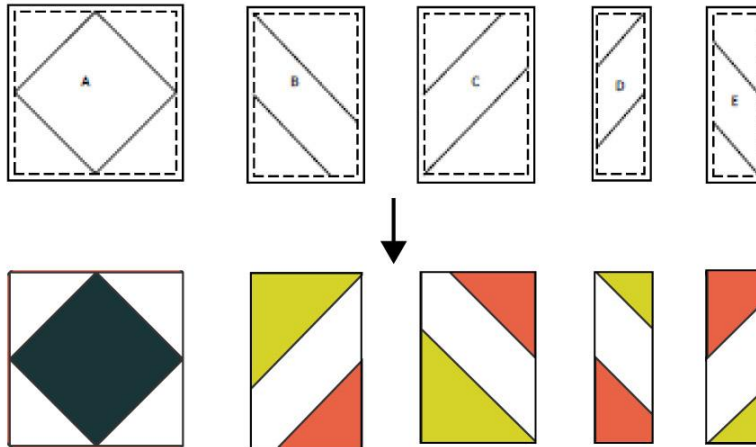
- Three coloured fabrics
- Background fabric

In this block Colour 1 is yellow, Colour 2 is pink and Colour 3 is blue.

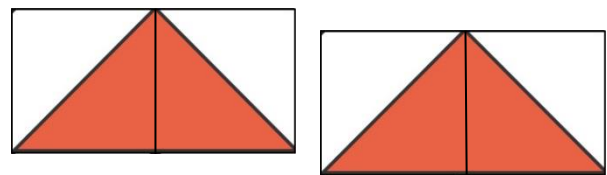
This is another paper pieced block mixed in with some traditional piecing. For basic paper piecing instructions, see the November instructions.

**Instructions**

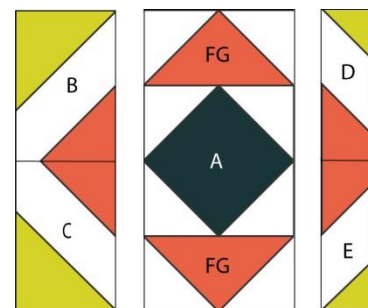
1. Print out one of each template A, B, C, D and E. MAKE SURE PAGE SCALING IS SET TO NONE OR ACTUAL SIZE. Paper piece each template. Pay attention to fabric placement.



2. Make four half square triangles with Colour 2 and the background. Cut 2 – 4" squares of each fabric and sew  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the diagonal, trim to 3.5" square.
3. Piece pairs of HSTs into two flying geese.



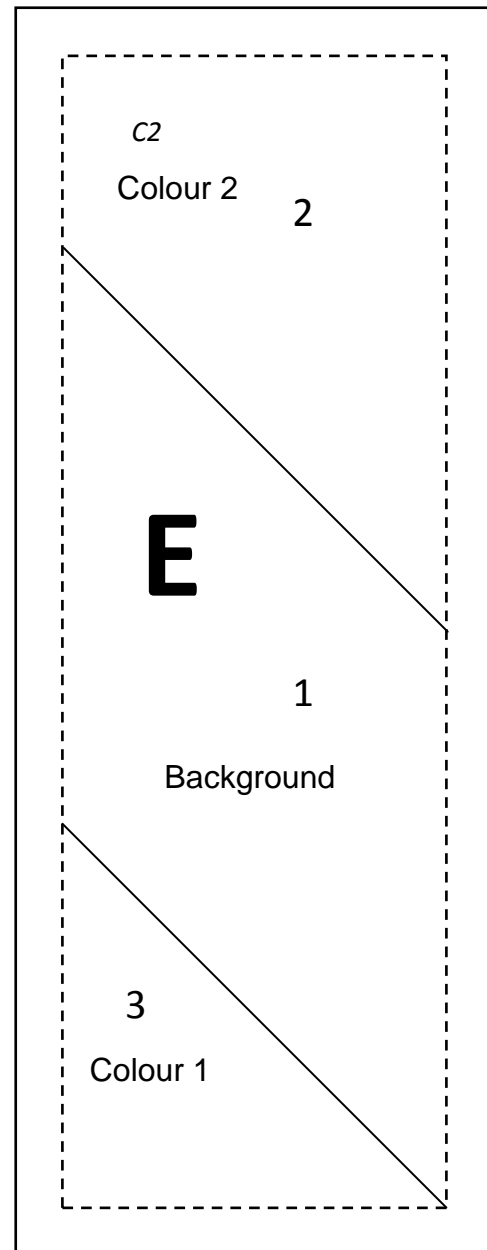
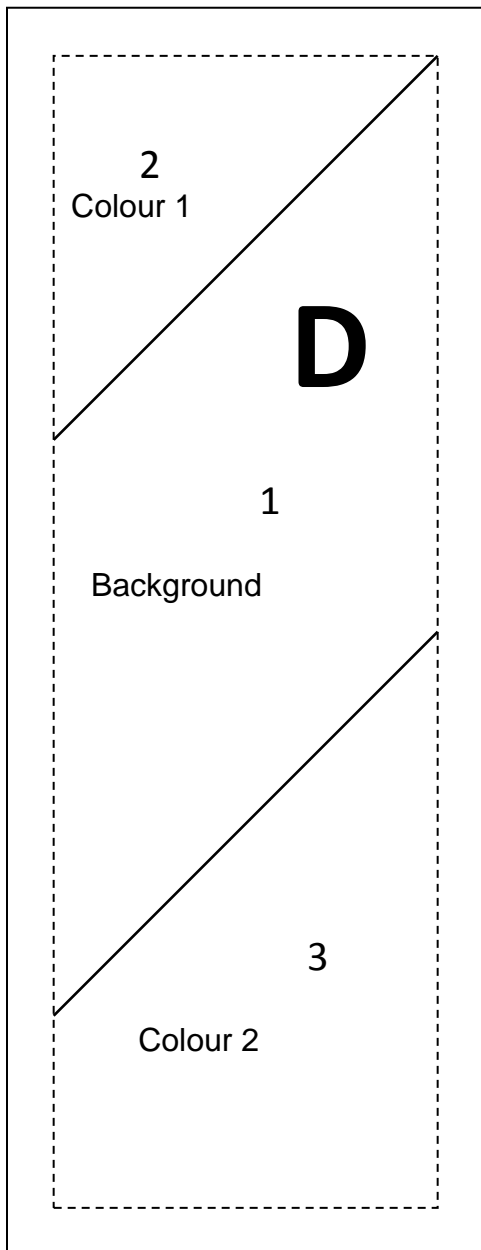
4. Piece together:
  - Templates B and C
  - Template A with the flying geese
  - Templates D and E
5. Sew each column together to finish the block.

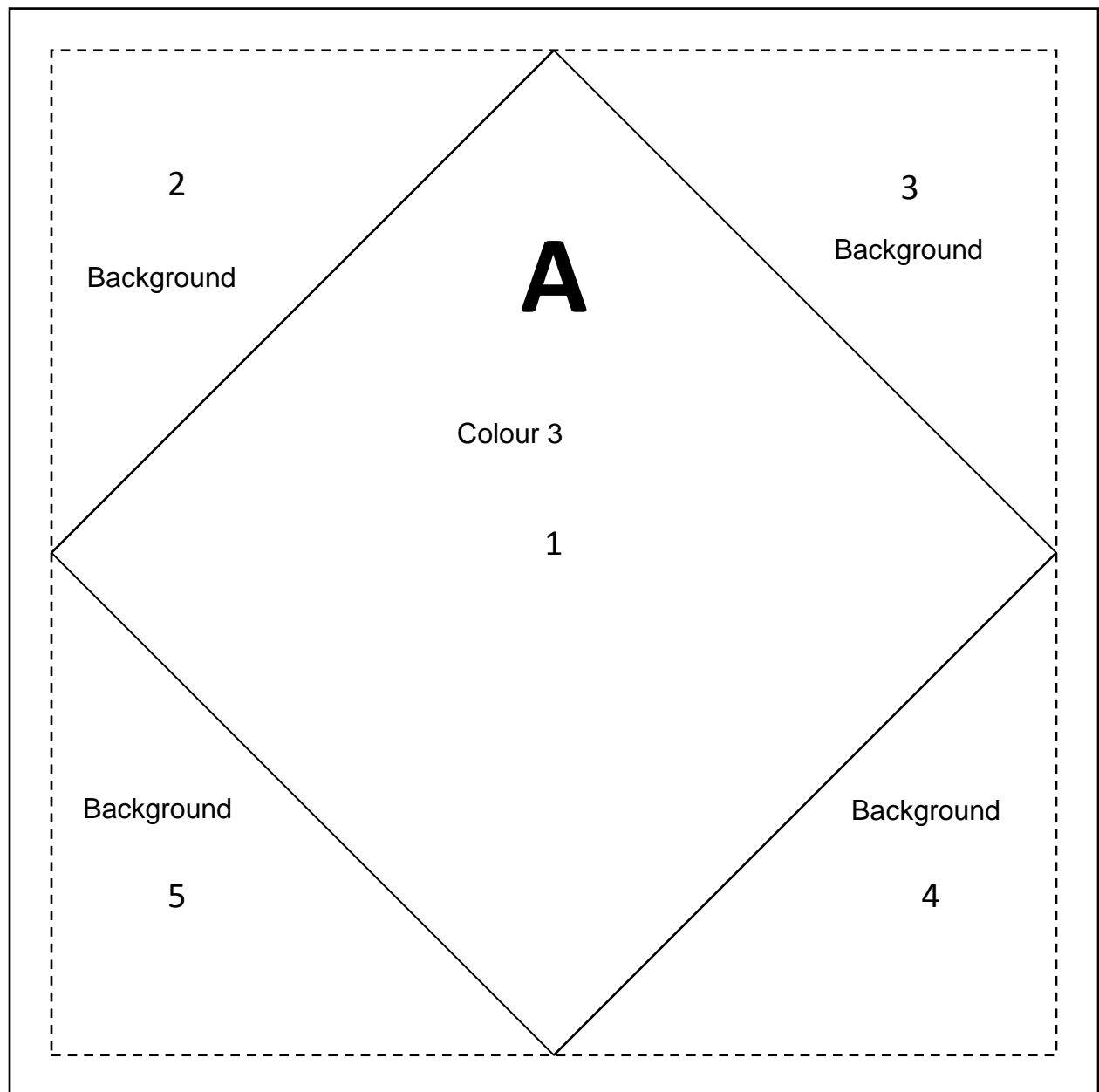

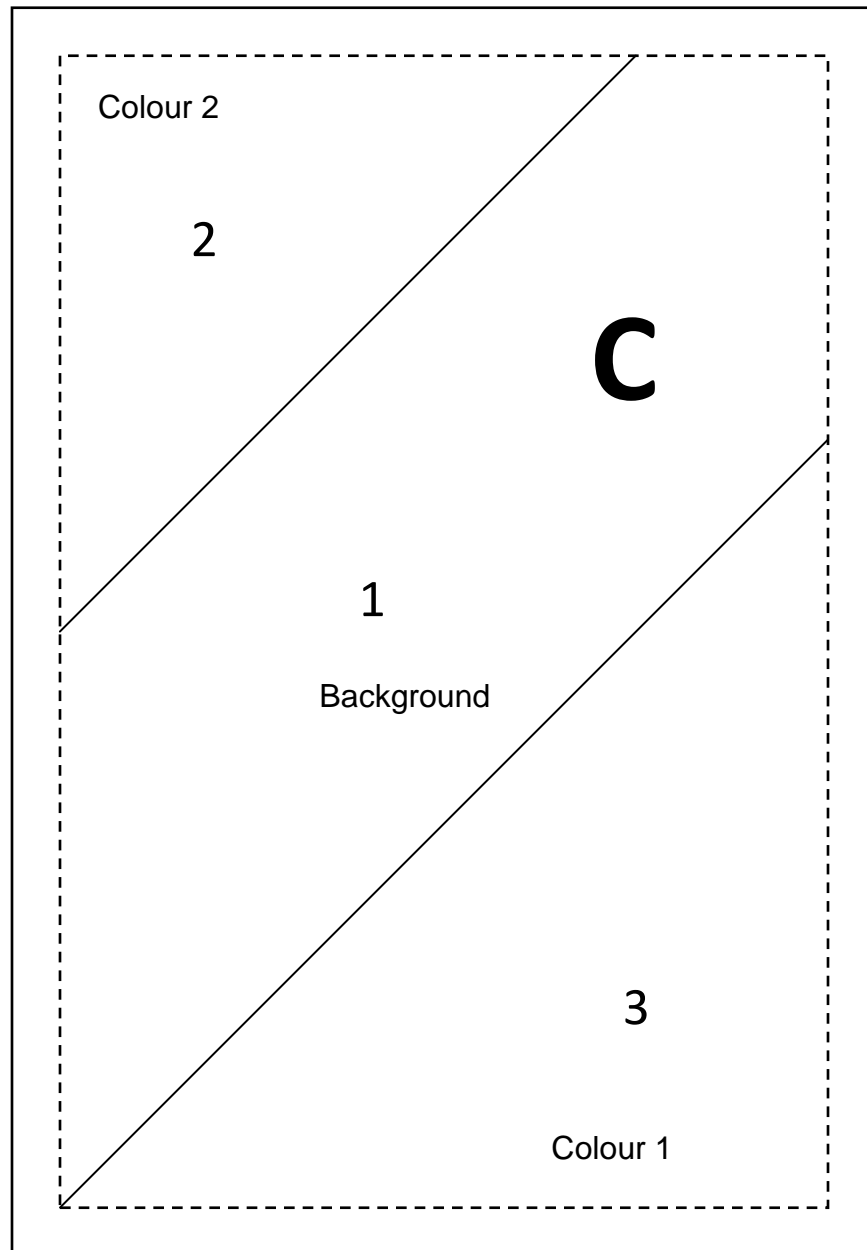
